## APPLICATION FOR AFFILIATION

**With the Western Australian Association of Caravan Clubs Inc.  
(Also known as Caravanswest)**

Any Caravan or Motor-home club is invited to become affiliated with the Association so that a united voice can be put forward on behalf of all caravanners and recreational travellers.

Member benefits:

- As an incorporated body your club is eligible to be included and covered by the Association's Public Liability Insurance. The cost of insurance is in addition to being affiliated, by a levy which all member clubs are required to pay at the rate of approx. \$3.00 per person (per head) each year, the actual amount decided at the Annual General meeting in November each year.
- Affiliated clubs receive the Association's 50-page magazine "WA CARAVAN & CAMPING" which is supplied free in April and November each year with a copy for every club member (couple) or single member category. It contains news of other clubs and items of interest to all caravanners.
- The Association is represented on the State Government Advisory Committee for Caravan Parks and Camping Grounds, and has input into new caravan park legislation, and other matters in respect to caravanning.
- A Combined Clubs' State Rally is held every two years and a National Rally of Clubs in Australia is held every three years. Only club members are able to attend.
- Your Club appoints a Delegate and Proxy to the Association, and both are invited to attend meetings, which are held on the third Wednesday of every second month, from January.
- Collectively, the more caravanners the Association represents, the more chance we have of improving the 'lot' for caravanners with Government, Local Government and prospective developers.

Each year, the Association needs the names, addresses, and phone numbers of your President, Secretary and Treasurer, as well as similar details for your appointed Delegate and Proxy. They are sent meeting reminders, minutes etc., to in turn report to the Club's Executive. E-mail addresses if available are also requested for Association Delegates and Club Secretaries.

To comply with our Public Liability Insurance Policy, the State Secretary must be advised of all club members' names and the proposed venues up to six months in advance. This does not contravene any Privacy Act provisions and the information supplied is only sighted by the Secretary.

As at November 2010, affiliation fee is \$80 per club, per annum, renewable in November/December each year. The amount is set at the Association’s AGM in November. **(Clubs applying for affiliation only pay 50% of the fee in the first year of joining.)**

Clubs are required to pay Public Liability Insurance levy of \$3. 00 per adult person (Children exempt) when the application is accepted by the Association, together with the \$40 (first year discount) for affiliation.
