

**BY-LAWS OF THE
WESTERN AUSTRALIAN ASSOCIATION OF CARAVAN CLUBS INC.**

1. STANDING COMMITTEES

1.1. AIMS & OBJECTIVES

1.1.1. GOVERNMENT & BUSINESS LIAISON

Aim: To provide appropriate information on caravanning to Government, Local Government and the Caravan Industry and monitor activities of these bodies which could impact adversely on caravanning lifestyles of members and the wider population of caravanners.

Committee members also should support the representative appointed to the Caravan Parks and Camping Grounds Advisory Committee. (Under Minister for Local Government).

Also involvement/representation on the organisation known as W.A.R.C.O.

1.1.2. TOURISM & PUBLIC AFFAIRS

Aim: To promote caravanning as an enjoyable lifestyle activity.

- Prepare and maintain displays on caravanning and club activities for use in shopping centres, as back up to speakers, and at public events such as the Caravan, Camping, and Park Homes Show, "Have a Go Day", etc.
- Arrange for speakers to be available for Seniors Days, Retirement Seminars and on request, to encourage caravanning.
- Operate Training Clinics for potential and new caravanners with the view of safety and competence on the roads.
- Produce brochures, leaflets, and handouts to promote caravanning generally.

1.1.3. NEW CLUB DEVELOPMENT

Aim: Develop and foster the formation of caravan clubs in the metropolitan area and regional areas of Western Australia.

Activities to cover club rallies, constitution and incorporation, membership, finance, meetings, election of office-bearers, etc.

1.1.4. STATE AND NATIONAL RALLIES

Aim 1: Organise and operate all aspects of combined clubs rallies in Western Australia every two years. (Usually end of September LWE in 2002, 2004, 2006,2008 etc.

Activities include venue selection, program of events, marshalling, entertainment, catering, etc.

Aim 2: Assist and facilitate club members in attending National rallies at interstate venues in 2004/5, 2007/8, 2010/11, etc. In due course act as host body when the venue is W.A.

Activities to be developed in liaison with members who have previously attended an interstate national rally.

1.2. GUIDELINES

1.2.1. Members elected to a standing committee in accordance with Cl. 9 shall elect one of their number to be chairperson.

1.2.2 A Standing Committee established under the Constitution Cl. 9 shall at all times be represented by the Chairperson who shall be the only person empowered to speak for, or on behalf, of a standing committee.

1.2.3. A standing committee shall be vested with the full power to represent WAACCI on any organisation to which WAACCI is invited to send a representative or to which WAACCI wishes to express an opinion or observation.

1.3. MEETINGS

1.3.1. All standing committees to meet on a regular basis.

1.3.2. A proper record of any meeting and of any correspondence entered into or any representation made to any organisation shall be kept.

1.3.3. A copy of all records shall be made available to the Secretary on a regular basis. (Cl. 9.2)
